### **The Greenville County Library System Launches Bookmobile Stop in Northern Greenville County**

**The new bookmobile stop will begin on May 11, 2010 from 2:00p-4:30p at the Hometown Superette IGA located on Geer Highway in Marietta.** The bookmobile collection provides the same variety of material formats available at branch locations, including best sellers and popular audiovisual materials. Additionally, patrons will be able to request items from any library location to be routed for pickup at the new bookmobile stop.
