How do choices, challenges and consequences relate to the paradox of affluence? Join in the discussion of wealth and society following a video presentation by three leading experts.

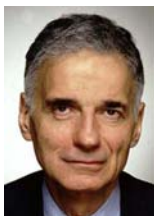
