Greenville, SC – The Greenville County Library System’s Summer Reading program will kick off on **Friday, May 28 at 4:30p** with a concert featuring Roger Day!

Children ages 0-12 and teens (rising 6th-12th graders) are invited to sign up for Summer Reading. Summer Reading begins at the kickoff and ends on July 31.

Summer Reading has been a tradition at GCLS since the 1930s, registering over 10,000 participants in 2009. The Summer Reading program is divided into two levels: children and teens. Participants may sign up for the program at any of our library locations, then read books and earn prizes. In conjunction with Summer Reading, we have “summer specials” featuring hired entertainers who provide a variety of programs.
