Ribbon Cutting at the Greenville County Library System's Satellite Location in Slater Hall Annex

Greenville, SC - The Greenville County Library System is expanding library services to the Slater-Marietta community!

On **Thursday, May 28, 2009 at 12:00p**, the Library System presented a ribbon-cutting event at the new satellite library at the Slater Hall Annex. In response to community requests and an offer from the Greenville County Recreation District to provide renovated space in the Slater Hall Annex to house the collection, the Slater Satellite Library will be open on an experimental basis. The level of usage over the next several months will help determine whether or not the Library System will maintain the service.

A collection of popular titles for adults and children are available on Mondays from 4:00p until 8:00p; Wednesdays from 10:00a until 2:00p; and Thursdays from 10:00a until 2:00p. Bookmobile service to the location will continue on Tuesdays on a bi-weekly basis from 2:00p until 4:30p.

The Slater Satellite Library is located at 5 Whitney St, Slater, SC 29683.
